This week we have celebrated our safety record and all of the effort each and every worker makes for safety. We are now looking to the future and carrying on with our commitment to safety!

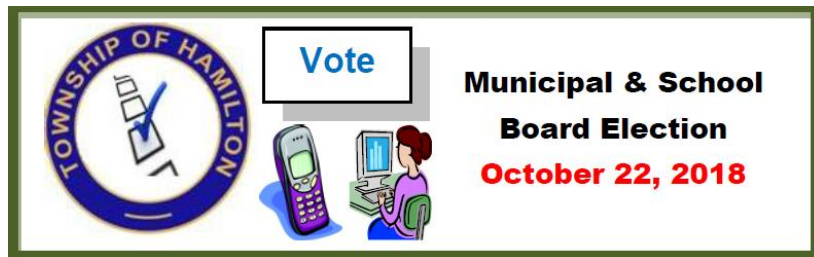
