Winter Maintenance and Snowplowing

The Township of Hamilton Public Works Department is responsible for maintaining our local roads. To ensure the safety of the motoring public during the winter months, this includes snowplowing and salting or sanding for icy conditions. Hamilton Township uses “treated salt” and an improved mixed sand/salt stockpiling method in a continuing effort to provide a high level of service during winter operations. This year Public Works initiated a trial program to improve safety related to road sanding on hills during freezing rain events.

We ask our residents to remove parked cars from the street/road prior to and during plowing or clearing operations so that equipment can safely clear the road of accumulated snow.

Residents are also reminded that when clearing snow from your driveways and entrances not to push the snow across the road or deposit snow or ice on the roadway.

Night Patrol

From November 15 to April 15, of each year, a Township employee patrols our roads from Monday to Friday - 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Should you have a road related emergency, please call 905-342-2810, and then press 3.
