We also have identified areas where there are parking restrictions, such as: specified period - time limited, fire routes, designated disabled parking areas and no parking at anytime.

Our enforcement team will be touring various parts of our community this weekend, and of course, throughout the year. Please offer our by-law enforcement officers your co-operation should you be speaking with them.

If you are travelling this weekend, please pay particular attention to the areas of concern, including:

- Waterfront areas- Harwood, Gores Landing and Bewdley
- Designated disabled parking areas
- Designated fire routes

You may be interested to know that Bewdley offers a large Municipal Public Parking Lot – with free Parking. Follow the Green P on Rice Lake Drive N., just east of the downtown and municipal dock.
