“Smoke and fire spread fast. There’s no time to figure out how to escape AFTER a fire starts. That’s why it is so important that everyone has working smoke alarms in their home and that they practice a home fire escape plan with everyone in their household BEFORE there’s a fire.”

Hamilton Township Fire Department encourages all home owners to develop and practice a home fire escape plan. Everyone in your home should know what to do, and where to go should your fire alarm sound. Follow the link below to help your family draw a floor plan for each level of your home.
