



Parks and Recreation Summer Student

This job consists of mostly outside work and can be labour intensive. Some of the duties include:

- Cutting and trimming grass at municipal parks throughout the Township
- Preparation and maintenance of ball diamonds
- Painting and cleaning recreational facilities
- Preparation for various events at recreation centres, as required
- General maintenance and repairs
- Assist with park and recreational facility improvements
- Other duties as assigned by the Manager

Good communications skills are required as the individual may be required to deal with the public. Also, candidates must have appropriate safety footwear. A valid full Class G driver's licence is preferred (Ontario Drivers Abstract will be required). First Aid/CPR training is an asset. Weekend work may be required. Successful candidates will be required to submit a satisfactory background check prior to the commencement of employment.

To be eligible for this position, you must be registered as a full-time student in the current year, and returning as a full-time student in the fall. You are available to work from May 6, 2019 until the end of August and be legally entitled to work in Canada. We will only be contacting those applicants who are selected for an interview.
