IMPORTANT: TRANSCANADA'S PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAM / PIPELINE SAFETY

At TransCanada, public and employee safety is a top priority. As the owner of one of North America's largest sweet natural gas pipeline systems, TransCanada has been a proud member in communities across Canada for over 65 years and we're committed to building and maintaining strong relationships with municipalities, landowners, occupants and neighbours.

Our records indicate that our pipeline or related facilities cross your property. Please, take some time to review the enclosed information regarding safety and permitted activities on or near our facilities. This package will inform you about our facilities, what we do to keep our pipelines safe, and the important role you play in pipeline safety.

Before you begin any work in the prescribed area (30 meters on both sides of the pipeline), or work within our right-of-way (ROW), you must contact Ontario One Call. You must contact Ontario One Call even if you only plan to cross our ROW with machinery.

TransCanada is a member of Ontario One Call (1-800-400-2255). This organization provides a 24 hour, 7 day a week underground facility notification service free of charge to anyone planning to dig in Ontario. Facility representatives will locate and mark their facilities prior to the start of any excavation activity. You can also request a locate online by visiting www.clickbeforeyoudig.com and selecting your province.
